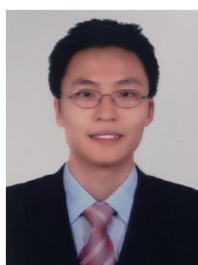
### **Mr. ANTON SHINGAREV – KASPERSKY LAB - Russia**

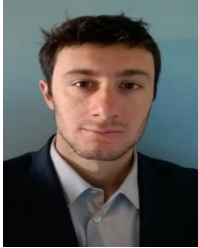
### **Mr. SHI WEI LIANG – HUAWEI TECHNOLOGIES - China**
